

Help.WindowsObject

NAME

`Windows Object` is used to find a specific windows object and do 'click' on that object. Its operation is very similar to `SelectWindow`, but this is more useful when images or object location to be compared often change.

SYNOPSIS

Parameter

XPath

The XPath of the target object. You can get an XPath by clicking the below icon and selecting a desired object.



ActionType





For now, `Click` is the only one.

(More ActionType will be added soon !)

Click point

The point at which to click on the window object.

ClickType

icon	click
	(Default) Click the left button
	Click the right button
	Double-click the left button
	Move the mouse

1. Start  icon

/Group[@ClassName="TileListViewItem"][@Name="Command Prompt's group  
group header"]  
/ListItem[@ClassName="TileListViewItem"][@Name="Notepad"]
```

- Developer mode needed.

Note:

It's need 'Developer mode'.
